The Oxford Drug Awareness Committee invites young people to help increase awareness of the effects of drug use. Young people from Oxford County are encouraged to make and submit videos that illustrate the effects of substance use on one of the following topics:

- Overdose
- Alcohol
- Marijuana
- Driving under the influence of drugs/ alcohol

RULES- Video must:

- Be less than 3 minutes long
- Contain at least one credible and accurate statistic/message about topic chosen
- Be developed by youth (must be age 14-24)
- Not depict any brand or logo, or mention names of companies or organizations
- Not depict any illegal activity, profanity, sex or direct attack on people or organizations
- Submitted with consent forms for everyone in the video to: 93 Graham Street, Woodstock, ON, or send consent forms along with a link to your uploaded YouTube video to ODACcontest@oxfordcounty.ca **before April 28, 2017**

Judging Criteria: ODAC members and SWAC students will judge videos and will look for the following:

- Was the message clear, effective and persuasive? Would your friends listen to this message?
- Level of creativity
- Was the information accurate and credible?
- How well was the story developed and message delivered?
- Was the use of actors/presenters/animations appropriate?
- Was the camera work well done?

Videos can be live-action, animation, claymation, whatever – as long as they meet all the rules above. If you have any questions, please contact ODACcontest@oxfordcounty.ca. Winning videos will be announced at the **Youth Film Festival Celebration** at the Oxford County Administration Building (21 Reeve Street) on May 18, 2017 from 5-8 pm. The top rated videos will also be shown at **The Woodstock Art Gallery** on May 31, 2017.
