

**COUNTY OF OXFORD**

**BY-LAW NO. 5514-2013**

**BEING** a By-law to establish water and sanitary sewage rates for various systems in Oxford County for the years 2014 to 2016, commencing February 1, 2014.

**WHEREAS**, Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority.

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 11 (2) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, provides that the County of Oxford, as an upper-tier municipality, may pass by-laws with respect to the financial management of the municipality and its local boards and services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide.

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 11 (3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, provides that the County of Oxford, as an upper-tier municipality, may pass by-laws respecting the matters within the spheres of jurisdiction outlined in that section.

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 11 (11) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, prescribes that the County of Oxford has exclusive jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the production, treatment, storage and distribution of water, and the collection and treatment of sanitary sewage within the County of Oxford.

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, provides that the County of Oxford may impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by the County or for the use of County property.

**AND WHEREAS**, the County of Oxford has acquired, installed or otherwise had vested to its responsibility the water supply systems and sewage treatment and collection systems listed in Schedules A, B and C, attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF OXFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the rates for the supply of water and the rates for sanitary sewage collection and treatment for users of the systems, shall be imposed as specified in Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming part of this By-law effective February 1, 2014.
2. That the rates for the supply of water and the rates for sanitary sewage collection and treatment for users of the systems, shall be imposed as specified in Schedule "B", attached hereto and forming part of this By-law effective January 1, 2015.
3. That the rates for the supply of water and the rates for sanitary sewage collection and treatment for users of the systems, shall be imposed as specified in

Schedule "C", attached hereto and forming part of this By-law effective January 1, 2016.

**READ** a first and second time this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2013.

**READ** a third time and finally passed in this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2013.
