

Note: Thomas Richard Mayberry (1854 – 1934) began his political career serving as the Clerk-Treasurer of West Oxford Township, before later serving as a councillor and reeve of the Township. In 1888, he was elected as Warden of Oxford County. In 1908, he was elected to the Ontario Legislature, defeating Hon. Donald Sutherland by a majority of 203. Serving as a Liberal, he would be re-elected in the 1911 provincial election, but defeated in 1914.

Mayberry also took part in the Militia and was the Lieut. Colonel and officer commanding the 24th Gray's Horse Regiment during WWI, and was the secretary and manager of the Dereham and West Oxford Mutual Fire Insurance Company for more than 40 years. He also served at one point as Chairman of the Ingersoll Board of Education; was a member and auditor of the Ingersoll, North and West Oxford Agricultural Society; was the chairman of the Agricultural Committee of the Ingersoll Kiwanis Club; and served as a Deacon at the Ingersoll Baptist Church.
