

COUNTY OF OXFORD

BY-LAW NO. 5160-2010

BEING a By-law to repeal By-law No. 4709-2006 and to set a new fee for the municipal waste collection of residential waste effective May 1, 2010.

WHEREAS, section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 chapt. 25 provides that Oxford County has exclusive authority over the entire sphere of waste management with the exception of shared jurisdiction over waste collection.

AND WHEREAS, Council passed By-law No. 3604-96 respecting upper-tier assumption of waste management powers under section 150 of the Regional Municipalities Act by reference from subsection 126(7) of the County of Oxford Act.

AND WHEREAS, section 12 of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a By-law passed under section 150 of the Regional Municipalities Act continues in force despite section 11 and has the same effect as it had on December 31, 2002.

AND WHEREAS, it is desirable to set a user pay fee for bag tags to encourage continued diversion of household waste through recycling.

AND WHEREAS, Council has adopted Public Works Report D-5 2009-88 dated October 28, 2009.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the County of Oxford enacts as follows:

1. Effective May 1, 2010 the price for road-side and curb-side collection of residential waste is \$1.50 per bag and shall be implemented as follows:
 - i) one bag tag shall be used for each garbage bag (up to 76 x 96 cm) or each rigid container (up to 128 litres) and each such bag or container must weigh less than 20 kg.
 - ii) two bag tags shall be used for each rigid container with a volume between 129 and 240 litres and this container must also weigh less than 20 kg.
 - iii) three bag tags shall be used for each rigid container with a volume between 241 and 360 litres.
2. That any dispute concerning the implementation or interpretation of this By-law may be resolved by Council without amendment to this By-law.
3. By-law No. 4709-2006 is hereby repealed.

READ a first and second time this 24th day of March, 2010.

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of March, 2010.
