Apply for the subsidized and fast-tracked 21-week Personal Support Worker program

Are you interested in making a difference in the health and well-being of individuals and families? Do you envision being a part of a healthcare team? If so, at no cost to you consider becoming a Personal Support Worker (PSW) by enrolling in an employer-sponsored program between Woodingford Lodge and Conestoga College for the new PSW FAST program. Woodingford Lodge will accept and sponsor 10 applicants.

What do I need to apply?

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent, or 19 years of age or older with mature student status
- Grade 12 compulsory English, C or U level, or equivalent
- Previous post-secondary program (a degree, diploma or certificate from an accredited college or university) or experience in healthcare in the last two years (proof of current/recent employment in the healthcare field is required)
- Copy of official transcripts
- Current resume
