## HUMAN SERVICES



### HOUSING SUPPORT

- 636** subsidized public housing units
- 600** not-for-profit housing units
- 538** affordable housing units
- 68** Canada-Ontario Housing Benefit Applications completed



### CHILDREN'S SERVICES

- 715** families receiving child care fee subsidy, with 660 children served
- 1,310** unique parent/care providers served by an EarlyON program or service
- 10,015** visits made by parents/care providers to an EarlyON program or service



### FINANCIAL HELP

- 2,895** residents and families aided through financial assistance and employment supports
- 164** families supported through the rent supplement program



## PARAMEDIC SERVICES

- 19,232** paramedic call responses
- 4,097** community paramedicine visits to 147 individuals
- 529** 911 calls diverted to Community Paramedicine Program
- 492** in-home vaccinations for vulnerable, marginalized or homebound populations

## WOODINGFORD LODGE

- 228** long-term care beds
- 146** residents supported on the journey to long-term care through the Family Transition Program
- 89%** consolidated global satisfaction among our residents across all three Woodingford Lodge sites (Woodstock, Ingersoll and Tillsonburg)

## ROADS & BRIDGES

- 1,311** lane kms of County roads maintained
- 34** kms road resurfacing
- 161** bridges & culverts maintained
- 12** new pedestrian crossings (2020-22)



## WATER & WASTEWATER

- 17** municipal water systems serving 21 Oxford communities, with 10.9 million m<sup>3</sup> of drinking water treated
- 9** municipal wastewater systems serving 11 Oxford communities, with 13.6 million m<sup>3</sup> of wastewater treated



## WASTE MANAGEMENT

- 55%** curbside waste diversion rate
- 45%** landfill waste diversion rate



## FACILITIES, FLEET & ENERGY MANAGEMENT

- 1,502** kW (AC) of solar photovoltaic systems across 19 different County facility sites
- 3,667,000** kWh of renewable energy generated
- 310** buildings and more than 204 fleet assets maintained



## WOODLANDS & SOURCE WATER PROTECTION

- 774+** hectares of woodland properties managed by and under stewardship of Oxford County, including 345 hectares of forest and 288 hectares of wetlands/ source water protection lands
