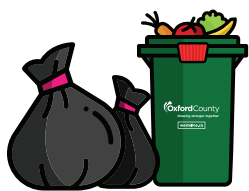


Collection schedule update

Woodstock downtown corridor (Zone 5a)

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2026



Beginning October 6, 2026, businesses and residents in downtown Woodstock will receive twice weekly garbage and green bin organics collection every **Tuesday and Friday**, with adjustments made for statutory holidays. **This change applies only to the Dundas Street corridor and laneways between Vansittart Avenue and Wilson Street.**

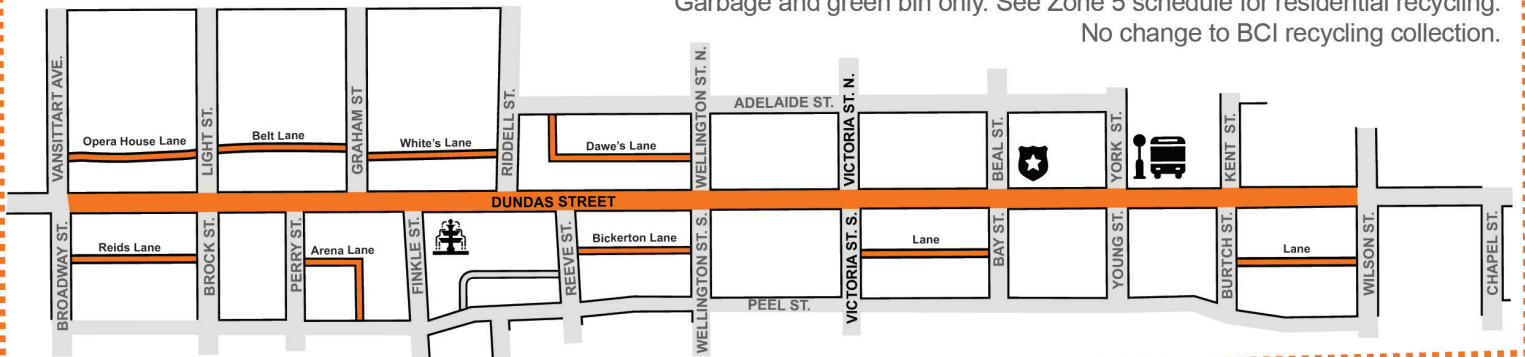
This is an interim schedule in place until December 31, 2026, until a longer term schedule is approved by Oxford County and City of Woodstock Councils.

Downtown Woodstock core

Dundas Street and laneways only. Side streets not included.

Garbage and green bin only. See Zone 5 schedule for residential recycling.
No change to BCI recycling collection.

Corridor area: New collection days for garbage and green bins apply to the **Dundas Street corridor and laneways only, between Vansittart Avenue and Wilson Street.** The regular six-day collection schedule remains in place for side streets and the rest of Zone 5.

Set-out time: Please set out your garbage and green bin no later than 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday and Friday mornings.

Recycling: Residential blue box recycling collection is not changing and will continue with separate collection schedules for business and residential (see other side).

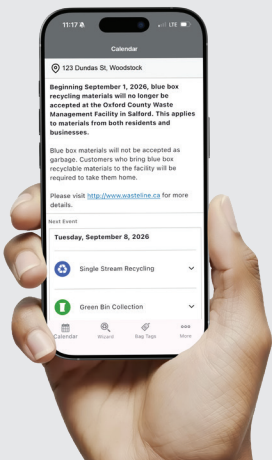

Garbage + green bin (organics)		
Collection days	Every Tuesday and Friday (New Zone 5a) • Please set out no later than 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday and Friday mornings • See new Zone 5a collection schedule for collection dates, including alternate days for statutory holidays	
Set-out	• at front of building within 1 metre / 3 ft of curb, at the edge of the curb to avoid blocking sidewalk • business: back laneway behind building where applicable	
Containers/bags	• garbage: tied bag weighing under 20 kg / 44 lbs, with 1 bag tag for each bag around neck of bag • organic waste: 45-litre green bin (one courtesy container provided by Oxford County at no cost)

Recycling (blue box materials)		
Collection days	• once every six (6) business days before 7:00 a.m. (see Zone 5 schedule)	• weekly on Tuesday mornings before 7:00 a.m. Must be registered for BCI (Business, Commercial, Institutional) recycling. Contact bcirecycling@oxfordcounty.ca
Set-out	• at front of building within 1 metre / 3 ft of curb, at the edge of the curb to avoid blocking sidewalk • business: NOT in back laneways	
Containers Sorting is not required. Containers and fibres (paper/cardboard) can be set out in same container.	• existing recycling containers (green/black) or request a blue box from Emterra Environmental: 1-888-597-1541 or customercareont@emterra.ca	• 83L and 360L Oxford County grey recycling containers; OR, • standard blue 83L and 360L recycling containers with BCI program sticker Note: businesses must register with Oxford County to participate.
