Oxford Road 19 (Otterville Road) bridge rehabilitation

Oxford Road 19, between Church Street and Bullock Street in Otterville will be reduced to a single lane with alternating traffic for bridge rehabilitation work in the Township of Norwich

About this project

Oxford County has awarded a contract to Urbanlink Civil Ltd. of Beamsville, Ontario, for bridge rehabilitation work on Oxford Road 19 (Otterville Road), between Church Street and Bullock Street in the Township Norwich.

The work includes full removal and replacement of the entire bridge structure including the deck and girders. Work is expected to be completed in two phases:

Phase 1: Construction on south side of structure; traffic alternating on the north side of the bridge.

Phase 2: Construction on north side of structure; traffic alternating on the south side of the bridge.

Construction work is tentatively scheduled to begin in early April 2026, and is expected to be completed by December 2026. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

During construction, Oxford Road 19 (Otterville Road) will be reduced to a single lane of traffic between Church Street and Bullock Street with alternating traffic controlled by traffic control signals.

The south end of Church Street will be closed to serve as a construction staging area. Traffic will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services. A detour route will be in place for Church Street:

Detour: Maple Street and North Street West

Garbage and recycling

Access for waste collection is expected to be affected during construction. The contractor will collect homeowner containers and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to

mark garbage and recycling containers with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
