Oxford Road 29 bridge rehabilitation

Oxford Road 29 between 18th Line Road and Elisabeth Street will be closed for three weeks, then open for eastbound traffic only for bridge rehabilitation work in Innerkip

About this project

Oxford County has awarded a contract to Beton Construction for rehabilitation work on the Oxford Road 29 bridge between 18th Line Road and Elisabeth Street in the Township of East Zorra-Tavistock.

The scope of work for the bridge rehabilitation includes:

- converting to a semi-integral structure;
- replacing abutment bearings;
- installing new approach slabs;
- removing and replacing the concrete deck overlay and bridge railing system;
- removing and repairing concrete; and,
- asphalt paving the approaches.

Construction work is tentatively scheduled to begin in early May and is expected to be completed by November 2026. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control and access to property

For a maximum of three (3) weeks at the start of construction, Oxford Road 29 will be closed to all through traffic at the bridge to facilitate jacking and bearing replacement operations. Eastbound and westbound traffic will follow the designated detour route.

For the remainder of construction, Oxford Road 29 will maintain a single lane for constant eastbound traffic at all times. Westbound traffic will be required to follow the designated detour route.

Detour: Blandford Road, Oxford Road 8, 16th Line and Oxford Road 33

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions.

Curbside garbage, organics and recycling collection

There are no planned service disruptions at this time. Please follow your normal routine.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
