Location of Property:	The subject lands are described as Part of Lot 3, Concession 10 (Dereham), in the Town of Tillsonburg. The subject lands are located on the east side Cranberry Road lying between Ostrander Road and Beckett Boulevard and are municipally known as 20 Cranberry Road.
Description of Application:	The purpose of the application for Official Plan Amendment is to redesignate the lands from Low Density Residential to Community Facility to facilitate the severance of land and the development of a place of worship. The lands surrounding the proposed redesignation will remain as Low Density Residential for future development. The proposed place of worship will be approximately 1,300 m² (14,000 ft²) served by municipal water and wastewater services. In association with applications B25-49-7 and ZN 7-25-09.
