Construction of Tillsonburg Well 7A water treatment facility

A new on-site water treatment facility (Well 7A) will be constructed at 445 Broadway Street in the Town of Tillsonburg

Oxford County has awarded a contract to Baseline Constructors Inc. of Waterloo, Ontario, for construction of a new on-site water treatment facility at 445 Broadway Street in the Town of Tillsonburg. The scope of work includes demolition of the existing facility at 451 Broadway Street and site servicing improvements including watermain, sanitary sewer and storm sewer. This project is essential for enhancing the community's water infrastructure, improving water quality, and ensuring long-term sustainability of the drinking water supply system.

Construction of the Well 7A water treatment facility is tentatively scheduled to begin early November 2025 and is expected to be completed by December 2026. Construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on contractor availability and other operational demands.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

Broadway Street will remain open to traffic during construction. Work will be limited to 445 and 451 Broadway Street, with access to the construction site maintained through the existing entrance on Christie Street.

Water service

There are no planned service disruptions at this time. Residents will be notified in advance if temporary interruptions are required.

Garbage and Recycling

There should be no impact to regular household waste and recyclable collection.

Safety
